Sarah, Steve and Dave, This e-mail from Kate explains what was communicated to me regarding the UAC committee applicants. As per this evenings comments it appears one of the two community members who applied has been been forgotten and clearly only one ex council member had applied. A reminder that the adopting ordinance says we will have a minimum of 7 and max of 9 members. We currently have at least two vacant seats and two applicants.
